Attend and Achieve

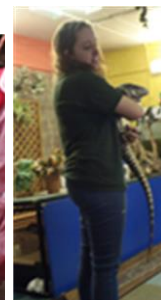
The Attend and Achieve assembly was held this week. The proud winners of the cup for June were **Owls Class** with an attendance of 98.3 %
