Marking Policy

Our marking policy encourages pupils to take responsibility for their own learning by creating a culture in which learning, marking, feedback and evaluation is at the heart of each lesson.

All pupils can expect to receive regular and consistent feedback which praises their efforts to learn and supports their next learning steps.

When Learning Objectives (LO) shared, pupil's learning, motivation and achievement is significantly improved. We recognise that it is important that children know what they must concentrate on and the purpose of the task. ensure the Success Criteria (SC) are clear and progressive and where possible created with the children, so that they when know they have achieved the LO.

When marking homework, we tick the piece of work meaning it has been read, and mark it with a "well done" stamp. For exceptional work we write a comment and award a Pasta Point or Pot of Gold.

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Phonics Workshop

A phonics workshop will be held on Thursday 6th December at 14:15. We will be providing a crèche for younger siblings.
