# Water, water everywhere

We have recently put the fantastic new class library books into classes. Friends of Swing Gate gave £4,500 for these and new books for the library. We have

already had some of these damaged alongside school reading scheme books. Unfortunately, some parents are putting water bottles etc in with reading books. Leaks have ruined some of them. Children only need to bring a book bag containing their reading books, and carry their water bottle. Books will only be sent home if the child has a book bag. They do not need to bring in back packs. We do not have the room to store them and if the children keep their books in them, they are not coming into the class room to be changed. Please help us to keep our systems working.

- Children only need a book bag
- The book bag should contain their books, reading record and spelling/ homework books
- Water bottles should not be put in book bags, a carrier bag will suffice
- CHILDREN DO NOT NEED BACK PACKS. We do not have enough room in our cloakrooms and they cannot be put in drawers as book bags can.

If we cannot access reading records etc. we cannot move the children on. The teachers are quite concerned and have asked me to raise this issue.


We look forward to welcoming parents of Rabbits to see what has been happening so far this term.
