#### **Class Trips**

#### **COVID Update**

Unfortunately, we have had additional recorded cases of COVID in school. There have also been a number of children sent home with 37 raised temperatures (anything over degrees). Please remain vigilant about checking for symptoms. You can either lateral flow test and return to school with a negative test result or keep your child at home for the isolation period (for under 18's it is three days from day zero when your symptoms appear or from a positive test). We are all rather exhausted by the relentlessness of the pandemic but in a bid to keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible we would appreciate your continued support.
