Squash Stars

Wellbeing in Action

Healthy Eating Super smoothie ice lollies

Ingredients

- 1 small ripe banana
- 1 mug of fresh or frozen berries (150g)
- 1 mug of milk (300ml)
- 3 tablespoons natural yoghurt
- 1 tablespoon runny honey
- 6 mint leaves

Method

- 1. Peel the banana and place in a blender with the berries, milk, yoghurt and honey.
- 2. Pick in the mint leaves, then blitz until super smooth.
- 3. Divide the mixture between 8 ice lolly moulds, then pop a stick into each one. Put

the ice lollies in the freezer for at least 4 hours, or until solid.

Tips:

A super-ripe banana will add extra sweetness, so depending on its ripeness you might need a little more or less honey.
